

Rain delayed matters, but City Power resolved the issue as soon as they could.

**Johannesburg Water**



This past month, there were several blocked sewerage pipes and burst water pipes.

Neerlandia in Halfway Gardens had several issues, leaving some residents without water for a few days.



Low or no water pressure plagued some residents several times, of which some cases seem to be related to the Abland development.

The VVRA drove around reporting as many potholes as possible. Some major potholes have been left for months without repair.

We urge residents to download the JRA app - find & fix to report Potholes, Traffic Signals, Stormwater drainage, Signage, Manhole covers, and several other issues relating to JRA.

Once again JMPD attempted to remove informal recyclers that are fouling up the area behind Chris Barnard, but as soon as JMPD left they were back again.



These recyclers confirmed that they live in a nearby township, yet they live here behind the residents of Chris Barnard, with no regard for health issues, using the residents back walls as toilets, leaving rubble and litter all over the area, bring with it huge rats that run around in this unhygienic area.

They started off with only 2 or 3 informal recyclers but since then other informal recyclers have taken to moving in here as well. Last count was 8 informal recyclers.

**Abland Development in Vorna Valley**

We have had several issues with the Abland Developers who seems to do as they please and leave residents at risk on roads that are under construction and even closed off Elizabeth Fry without public participation.



Their contractors chopped down trees illegally, demolished the VVRA garden sponsored by Platinum, leaving trees vulnerable to fall over, closing of roads like Pretorius and Harry Galaun leaving no room for pedestrians. The VVRA tried to have a meeting regarding the closing off of Elizabeth Fry, but our councilor decided to have a meeting with Abland and JRA without informing the VVRA. Council advised Abland to stop the closing off of Elizabeth Fry but they continued anyway.

VVRA thought it necessary to start a petition to get council to start listening to residents and not let developers walk all over us. It then quickly became very apparent that this road was indeed closed off illegally.

Developers in Midrand has closed Elizabeth Fry Road illegally at its intersection with Harry Galaun in Midrand. The developers applied for a permanent road closure with Johannesburg Property Company but to date the applicant has not yet been processed by the City. JRA indicated that we would supported the permanent closure from a technical point of view as part of the Traffic Impact Study for the development but the support was subject to the closure only being valid once it has been approved by Council. Not having received a response from the City on their application, the developer decided without authorization to close the road illegally to accommodate construction along Harry Galaun.

We hereby request that JMPD issue the contractor/ developer with a notice of illegal construction within the road reserve (they have closed the road without authorisation by Council) and instruct them to open it. JRA Development Control will provide you with a copy of the letter issued to the developer in which we set the conditions they failed to adhere to prior to closing the road.

The VVRA contacted JMPD and SPCA, and thankfully the SPCA came out as soon as they could to oversee the slaughtering of these goats on residential property.



World TB Day, falling on **March 24th** each year, is designed to create public awareness that tuberculosis today remains an epidemic in much of the world, causing the deaths of nearly one-and-a-half million people each year, mostly in developing countries.

**What is TB?**

Tuberculosis (TB) is a disease caused by germs that are spread from person to person through the air. TB usually affects the lungs, but can also affect other parts of the body, such as the brain, kidneys or the spine.

**How is TB spread?**

When a person with TB of the lungs coughs, sneezes, speaks or sings, TB germs from the lungs are expelled into the air. TB germs can survive longer in a dark enclosed place and remain suspended in the air for several hours. These germs can be inhaled by anyone who shares the same air and cause infection.

**How can TB infection be prevented?**

TB can be prevented by: | Covering your mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing | Opening windows and doors at home and in crowded rooms, churches, buildings and taxis | Exercising regularly | Eating enough healthy food | Stopping smoking | Avoiding alcohol intake | Visiting the clinic if you have been in contact with someone with TB or if you have any of the symptoms of TB.

**How do I know if I have TB?**


You may have TB if you have any of these symptoms: | A cough for two weeks or more | Night sweats | Unexplained loss of weight | Fever | THINK I MAY HAVE TB? WHAT SHOULD I DO? If you think you have TB, visit your nearest clinic for a FREE TB TEST. The nurses will ask you to cough into a bottle and your sputum specimen will be sent to the laboratory for examination. If you have TB, you will be given medicine right away. There is no charge for TB medicine. Health care workers and treatment supporters will help you take your medicines every day for as long as you need.

**Can TB be cured?**

TB disease can be cured if treated early. You should take the medicine for at least six months. It is very important to take the medicines as prescribed and finish all of them. If you stop taking anti TB drugs too soon, you could get sick again. You could also get a kind of TB that will not respond to the common medicines used to treat it (Drug-Resistant TB)

It's illegal and could cost you R20 000!

Johannesburg City Parks and Zoo (JCPZ) has noted with grave concern reports of illegal felling of sidewalk trees around the City, says MMC FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT: NONHLANHLA SIFUMBA

"Trees are vital for the protection of our environment and for the beauty they add to our city. Additionally they reduce the effects of climate change by acting as a coolant, providing a vital food source, absorbing air pollutants and sustaining the natural habitat. "Street trees are the property of the City of Joburg and are protected by the City's by-laws. City Parks is usually inundated with reports of illegal tree felling during winter and autumn as residents battle with leaves that fall from the trees. "I appeal to all residents of our beautiful, green, and vibrant city to desist from this illegal act. The illegal felling of trees carries a fine of R2 000, and the offender is liable to pay a replacement value of the tree. The replacement value varies depending on the size, species, and location, but it ranges from R10 000 to R20 000.

"I would also like to encourage the law abiding citizens of our city to report any illegal felling of trees to the following numbers 072 241 0981 or (011) 375 5911. Alternatively, they can send an email to trees@jhbcityparks.com."

**LEVEL 1 WATER RESTRICTIONS**

**Statement**

City of Johannesburg residents are requested to reduce their water consumption patterns as water usage has increased at an alarming rate and this is of serious concern given the recent heat wave we have been experiencing since the beginning of 2018 in Gauteng.

When the National Department of Water and Sanitation lifted the water restrictions in early March 2017, it was agreed that the City of Joburg would retain some level of water restrictions. Residents are therefore reminded that Level 1 water restrictions are still in place.

***With Level 1 restrictions, watering of gardens is not allowed between 6am and 6pm in summer months (1 Sept to 31 March). Furthermore, it is not allowed to wash paved areas and driveway using hose pipes.***

Residents are also urged to continue to report all burst pipes, leaking water meters, open hydrants and to:

Residents can also implement the following water saving tips:

- Do not leave taps dripping.
- Wash your car on the grass. This will water your lawn at the same time.
- Use a watering-can instead of a hose pipe.
- Shorten your showering time.
- Use a glass of water to rinse when brushing your teeth.
- Take shallow baths. Avoid filling your bath to a depth greater than 100mm.
- Re-use water to water your garden or pot plants.

Water is a scarce commodity and Johannesburg Water is committed to provide a sustainable water and sanitation supply to all residents of the City. Level 1 water restrictions will be enforced by fines to consumers who contravened the Water Services By-law and consumers are urged to report non-compliance by phoning the JMPD 24/7 hotline on 011 758 9650.
